



**Terms and Conditions for the GASA  
50m Sprint Gala 2022**  
(Under Swim England Laws) License No 4SE220564

<b>Schedule of Events</b>
50m Butterfly
50m Backstroke
50m Breaststroke
50m Freestyle

1. This event is licensed by the Swim England Licence level 4 and will be subject to Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing
2. The competition shall be an age group event 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16+ (open), 25+ (Masters Mixed)
3. Age as at 31 December 2022
4. All entrants must be members of an affiliated club and amateurs as defined by the Swim England
5. These Championships are open to only those currently resident in the Bailiwick of Guernsey
6. Entries will be on a first come served basis.
7. Entry fee of £5.00 per event payable to GASA
8. Closing date for entries Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> February. No late entries accepted.
9. A swimmer may enter any number of events. No refunds will be made for withdrawal after the entry has been sent.
10. A withdrawal system will be in operation. There shall be no refund of entry fees to swimmers who withdraw from events, unless the withdrawal is for medical reasons.
11. Awards for the top three swimmers in each group on a points basis, 1<sup>st</sup> place - 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5 points, and so on down to 1 point for sixth place
12. Data Protection: With the submission of entry details, consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the Data Protection Act, to the holding, and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer to enable the running of the Meet.
13. A report together with the swimming results of the Gala may be published on our web site/ face book page; a press report may be submitted to/by the media, by entering this gala you are deemed to give permission for this information to be released. Should you not wish this information to be published please contact the office.
14. Any photographs of the medal winners and swimming events taken by the Guernsey Amateur Swimming Association/ Press Photographer might also be used as part of the report or released to the media. Should you not wish images of you/your child to appear on our social media sights or in the newspaper please contact GASA.
15. Meet participants must help to maintain a high standard of health and safety by not blocking stairways, emergency exits and walkways with bags and should report any issues immediately to a member of the pool staff or to the Meet Promoter
16. Covid-19: A good standard of hygiene will be adhered to. Hand sanitiser will be available on entering the pool area. All guidelines at the time of the event provided by the States of Guernsey public health will be adhered to.
